Overview

As a valued user of the Southampton Public Safety Foundation ("Foundation") website, protecting your personal information is of utmost importance to us. Our Privacy Policy helps you understand what information we may collect from you, how we use that information, and the choices you have regarding its use. Information Collection and Use

We may collect personal information, including but not limited to:

- Name, email address, and phone number (e.g., via our contact or scholarship forms)
- Donation/payment information
- IP addresses, device identifiers, and browsing behavior
- Interaction data (e.g., pages visited, forms submitted)
- Any data submitted voluntarily (e.g., survey responses, email communications)

We use this information to:

- Respond to inquiries and process donations
- Provide and improve our services

- Communicate with you regarding updates, events, or policy changes
- Assess scholarship eligibility
- Fulfill legal or regulatory obligations

We do not share your personal information with third parties, except as necessary to fulfill your request, comply with legal obligations, or protect our rights and users.

Your Rights and Choices

Please note that while we strive to honor requests, some data may be retained as necessary for compliance, dispute resolution, or internal recordkeeping.

Children and Minors

Our website is not intended for users under the age of 18. If we become aware that a child has submitted personal data without verified parental consent, we will take steps to remove that information. If you are a parent or guardian and believe your child has provided us with information, please contact us. For applicants under 18 applying for scholarships, we request parental or guardian consent.

Surveys

From time to time our site may request information via surveys. Participation in these surveys is completely voluntary. Information requested may include contact information (e.g., name and shipping address), and demographic information (e.g., zip code, age level). Survey information is used to monitor or improve the use and satisfaction of this site.

Cookies and Tracking

We use cookies, pixels, or similar tools to analyze site usage, store your preferences, and provide a secure experience. You can adjust cookie settings in your browser. Some features may not function without cookies.

Widgets

We may include third-party widgets (e.g., social sharing buttons). These may collect data and are governed by the third party's own privacy policies. We are not responsible for their practices.
